Active Ranks Update: Colonel Richard Fambro

The State Budget continues to be a big concern for the Division.

The Patrol has been dealing with both peaceful and not so peaceful demonstrations. Trooper and Professional Staff are taking care of the business of the patrol, and have been since March. At this time, there are many people who are retiring from the patrol. There are 17 people who will be retiring between now and October with over 420 years of experience. Since there is the hiring and promotion freeze, it is a difficult time.

Colonel Fambro asks retirees to keep their eyes and ears open and also sing the praises of the patrol. Budget projections are bleak and it may take until 2024 to get back to pre-COVID shape. Of our current members, 38% have less than 10 years of service. As of July 1st, we are heading back to our normal enforcement activity. Fatal crashes were up over 6% from the last two years.
